3 Competition Rules

3.5 Drynan Shield

- 1 The Competition will be held over a number of pre-determined dates as shown in the Club Handbook
- 2 Members, who wish to participate, are required to report, in person, by 6.30pm on the days the event takes place.
- 3 The draw will be made after the seeding of skips. A seeded skip can elect to play in another position with the agreement of his or her team members.
- 4 In the event of a triple playing a pair or four, the skip of the triple will only be allowed to play 2 bowls.
- 5 In the event of a pair playing a triple, 25% of the pair's total score will be deducted. In the event of a triple playing a four, 25% of the triple's total score will be deducted.
- 6 The number of ends will be determined by the Competition Steward on the day. The recommended length of game is 16 ends. The Steward may stipulate a fewer number of ends when triples (18 bowls per end) are played as opposed to pairs and fours (16 bowls per end) on the same day.
- 7 No trial ends will be played. The maximum number of shots gained on the first end will be restricted to 2 shots.
- 8 Each member accumulates points over the course of the season by use of the following points system: -

Best win on the day	7
Second best win on the day	5
Win	3
Draw	2
Loss	1
Attendees when play is cancelled	2
- 9 The member gaining the most points over the course of the season will be awarded the "Drynan Shield", which will be held for one year. Prizes will be awarded to the first and second places.
- 10 The Competition Steward will collect 50p per player.
- 11 Prospective members will be allowed to play in 3 consecutive Drynan Shield nights. Points will not be awarded retrospectively, if they become members of the Club.
